

## BMW TRAFFIC CAMERA INFORMATION.

Traffic Camera Information alerts you in advance about static safety and Traffic light cameras on the road ahead so you can be confident when driving your BMW. Visual and warning tones in the instrument cluster or head-up display, if equipped, provide information within your field of vision.

### ACTIVATING BMW TRAFFIC CAMERA INFORMATION.

BMW Traffic Camera Information must be activated before using on iDrive 7, Operating System 8 and Operating System 8.5 vehicles. On Operating System 9 vehicles, it is automatically activated with an active Digital Premium subscription and no other settings are available or required.

On Operating System 8 and Operating System 8.5, select **All Apps** > **Traffic Camera Information**. For iDrive 7 vehicle, select **Apps** > **Installed Apps** > **Traffic Camera Information**

On Operating System 8 and Operating System 8.5 you can also turn on/off the feature, including a warning tone. No such tone is available in Operating System 9 vehicles



## USING BMW TRAFFIC CAMERA INFORMATION.

When using BMW Traffic Camera Information, there are two useful display notification icons depending on the camera type.



Speed camera:

- Speed
- Red Light and Speed Combo



Red Light Camera:

• Red Light

While driving and approaching a camera, the distance countdown information appears and a warning tone will additionally sound, if activated. Depending on your vehicle equipment, the notification icons will appear in either the right or center of your instrument cluster.







### USING BMW TRAFFIC CAMERA INFORMATION.

The display of the traffic cameras can be changed in the display settings menu. You can select Head-up display or Instrument cluster.

Operating System 8 and Operating System 8.5

Per default setting, the instrument cluster is set to **off** and the Head-up display to **on**.

For OS 8 and OS 8.5, this can be changed by opening the **Displays** app and then selecting **Display location for lists/messages**. Select either **Head-up display** or **Instrument cluster**.

For OS 9, Traffic Camera Information notifications are automatically displayed within both the Head-up display and Instrument cluster at the same time.

For iDrive 7, this can be changed by selecting the **My Vehicle > Settings > Display Settings.** Select either **Head-Up display** or **Instrument panel**. In both menus **Route Warnings** will appear, select the preferred display location.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS.

#### 1. How can I confirm if my vehicle is compatible with Traffic Camera Information?

To confirm whether your vehicle is compatible, log in to <a href="www.bmwusa.com/MyBMWConnectedDrive">www.bmwusa.com/MyBMWConnectedDrive</a>. If compatible and active, Traffic Camera Information will be listed as one of your subscribed services. Or, if available for purchase, it will be listed within the ConnectedDrive Store as such.

- **2.** Once purchased, will my subscription to Traffic Camera Information be automatically extended? No, the users have to re-purchase the service on the ConnectedDrive store after the expiration.
- **3.** Is there any functional difference between the Traffic Camera Information Trial and full version? No, in terms of functionality, trial version and full version are the same.
- **4. Can I save my personal setting to Traffic Camera Information to my BMW ID?** Yes, the personal settings to Traffic Camera Information are saved with your BMW ID.

# 5. I purchased Traffic Camera Information, but cannot see it in my vehicle. Can I do anything to confirm it is installed to my vehicle?

On iDrive 7 vehicles, select **APPS** in the main menu and press the **OPTION** key in the iDrive controller. Then select **update services**. Traffic Camera Information should then be downloaded and be visible in the list of installed APPS. For OS 8 and 8.5 vehicles, open the **System settings** app and choose **Update apps and services**. For OS 9 vehicles, open the **ConnectedDrive Store** app, select **Manage** on the left navigation bar, then choose the refresh button (i.e., two arrows in a circle).

#### 6. How can I use the entertainment list if Traffic Camera Information is displayed?

Press the BC button, on suitably equipped vehicles, on the turn signal lever to allow the entertainment list to be used. Otherwise, you can display the entertainment list in your central display by pressing the MEDIA button on the center console.

- **7. Will Traffic Camera Information collect or store my personal data?** No personal data is stored or collected with this function.
- **8.** Is Traffic Camera Information also available for my guest accounts? Yes, the service is active by default on guest accounts.

#### 9. Does Traffic Camera Information include every camera in the U.S. and can I report one?

No, since the data source of Traffic Camera Information is crowd-based, some missing or false reports are inevitable. However, we seek to minimize misinformation. The current service version does not allow users to report new or missing cameras directly through the vehicle. # 10. If there are multiple cameras in an intersection, will my Traffic Camera Information display all of them in the display section?

Only the first camera will be shown. After passing the first camera, the upcoming cameras will be displayed one at a time.
