HOW TO ENABLE APPLE CARPLAY



Navigate to "All Apps" and click on "Apple CarPlay" in the Operating system menu.



Select "CarPlay" in the "Settings" menu of the iPhone to start the pairing process. Confirm BMW vehicle name once it appears on the available devices option list.




Now, your vehicle is attempting to discover the iPhone. Choose the iPhone you wish to pair under the "Select Device" option. Confirm the mobile device option you wish to connect by clicking on the iPhone name.


Please note, your iPhone must also have an active data plan, along with Siri, WiFi and Bluetooth capabilities turned on.

You may receive a verification code. If a code appears, confirm that the pairing code in the vehicle matches the pairing code on your iPhone by selecting "Pair".





Continue by selecting "Allow".



Acknowledge and confirm the Operating System message related to vehicle data. It is recommended that "Hey Siri" is selected before pressing continue. Now, click continue to link Siri to the vehicle. The "Hey Siri" option will allow for you to use voice assist to access CarPlay.

Your Operating System menu will take a moment to finalize Apple CarPlay activation. Once the Apple CarPlay screen loads, Apple CarPlay is ready for use.

HOW TO ENABLE APPLE CARPLAY






Acknowledge and confirm the Operating System message related to vehicle data. It is recommended that "Hey Siri" and the long press button are selected before pressing continue. Now, click continue to link Siri to the vehicle. The "Hey Siri" option will allow for you to use voice assist to access CarPlay.



You may receive a verification code. If a code appears, confirm that the pairing code in the vehicle matches the pairing code on your iPhone by selecting "Pair".





Continue by selecting "Allow".



Your Operating System menu will take a moment to finalize Apple CarPlay activation. Once the Apple CarPlay screen loads, your Apple CarPlay is ready for use.

The long press microphone button allows you to access Apple CarPlay via your steering wheel microphone button or the microphone widget on your Operating System. To activate, hold for 3-seconds.



SWITCHING BETWEEN Apple CarPlay™ AND BMW MODES.

Once Apple CarPlay is activated within your BMW, follow these steps to either unpair/disconnect/delete connection. This method is for Operating Systems 8 and newer.

Select "Mobile Devices" in "All Apps" to see all of the available connections under the "MY DEVICES" tab. If there are multiple devices paired, confirm that the iPhone you want is highlighted.



Switch between mobile devices.





In the "MY DEVICES" panel within the "MOBILE DEVICES" menu, click on the CarPlay icon below "MODE" on the Operating System screen to disconnect CarPlay. This will auto-connect Bluetooth. This is the preferred method for switching between devices.

Disconnecting and removing a connection.



In the "MY DEVICES" panel within the "MOBILE DEVICES" menu, click on the name of your device to display the full list of options.



From this menu, you are able to disconnect or remove device if you no longer wish to have your iPhone connected or stored.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS. OS8 and newer

- 1. Is there an easier way to access Apple CarPlay once the vehicle is paired?
 For Operating System 8, Apple CarPlay can be accessed via the CarPlay icon on the left-hand side of the Operating System menu if Apple CarPlay doesn't immediately initiate in the vehicle.
- 2. Apple CarPlay "Hey Siri" is not working. Why might this be?

 "Hey Siri" will not work if the feature is not turned on in the iPhone settings. To fix this go to the

 "Settings" then go to "Siri & Search" and confirm that the "Listen for "Hey Siri" option is selected.
- 3. What's the difference between a long press and a short press on the microphone button on the steering wheel?

 The long press microphone button allows you to access Apple Carplay via your steering wheel microphone button. Press the microphone button quickly to trigger Operating System speech.
- 4. Can I turn off CarPlay via my iPhone? Yes, access the CarPlay section in iPhone settings and tap on the green tab to turn off CarPlay.
- 5. Are there shortcuts available when using CarPlay?
 Yes, if CarPlay is active then all Operating System shortcuts will bring you to CarPlay shortcuts, such as the Media, Telephone and Navigation. Media will take you to CarPlay media source, Telephone will always take you to your iPhone menu and Navigation will bring you to Apple maps.
- 6. Can I connect my iPhone to CarPlay directly from the Bluetooth menu via my iPhone? Yes, put your iPhone into pairing mode by going to "Settings" > "Bluetooth" on your device. Then, follow the steps as previously outlined for Operating System 8 and wait for the pop up window to appear on your iPhone and Operating System. Complete by selecting "Use CarPlay" on you iPhone. Refer to the screenshots below.







HOW TO ENABLE APPLE CARPLAY



Navigate to "COM" on the Operating System. Select "CarPlay" in the "Settings" menu of the iPhone to start the pairing process. Click on the BMW vehicle name once it appears on the available devices option list.





Select "Mobile Devices" in the Operating system menu.



Confirm the mobile device pairing option by selecting "+ New Device".

Please note: In order to use both Wi-Fi Hotspot and CarPlay, join Wi-Fi Hotspot first before connecting to CarPlay.


Select "Phone calls and audio". Now, your vehicle is attempting to discover the iPhone. Please note, your iPhone must also have an active data plan, along with Siri, WiFi and Bluetooth capabilities turned on.



You may receive a verification code. If a code appears, confirm that the pairing code in the vehicle matches the pairing code on your iPhone by selecting "Pair".



Confirm the mobile device option you wish to connect by clicking on the iPhone name.




On the following screen, select "Confirm note and connect to Apple CarPlay".



SWITCHING BETWEEN Apple CarPlay™ AND BMW iDRIVE MODES. Once you have activated Apple CarPlay within your BMW, follow these steps:






Navigate to the "Com" menu in iDrive. Then, under the "Mobile devices" section, scroll to select the device you would like to connect via CarPlay.



Select "Connection mode" and choose between "BMW iDrive" mode or "Apple CarPlay".



If Apple CarPlay is selected a pop-up will appear, select "Confirm note".




Please Note: if this is the first time pairing to Apple CarPlay, you will have to select "Use CarPlay" on your iPhone as well.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS iDrive 7.

- 1. What are the requirements to use Apple CarPlay™ in my BMW? Apple CarPlay requires iDrive 5.0 or newer and BMW Navigation system. In addition, you must have an iPhone® 5 or newer running on iOS 9.3 or higher. Your iPhone must also have an active data plan, along with Siri, WiFi and Bluetooth capabilities turned on.
- 2. Can I connect my iPhone to CarPlay directly from the Bluetooth menu via my iPhone?
 Yes, put your iPhone into pairing mode by going to Settings > Bluetooth on your
 device. Then follow steps 2 through 4 on the previous pages and wait for the pop up
 window to appear on your iPhone and iDrive. Complete by selecting "Use CarPlay" on your iPhone.

- 3. Does my iPhone require a USB cable in order for it to connect via CarPlay? No. BMW enables the wireless and convenient use of your iPhone with CarPlay.
- 4. I've paired my iPhone as Apple CarPlay, why is my phone not connected via Bluetooth?

 After connecting to CarPlay, your iPhone's "Bluetooth" settings will show the vehicle's ID as "Not Connected."

 This is normal due to the wireless capabilities.



- 5. I'm still having connection issues, how can I fix it?
 In the event of connection issues, please make sure all boxes are checked in the menu located in: Communications > Mobile Devices > Settings.
- 6. Is CarPlay limited to just one main screen functionality?
 The CarPlay interface can have pages just like your iPhone home menus.
 However, there are direct links from your BMW's iDrive screens that will take you to the CarPlay menus when needed. For example, the Multimedia menu in iDrive will have a direct link to CarPlay.



7. If I'm already connected via Bluetooth is there a way to easily connect to Apple CarPlay? If you would like to switch modes, first check to see if the vehicle is displayed in the CarPlay settings of your iPhone. If so, ensure it is toggled 'on' as shown in image. Then follow the steps in this guide.
